<p>Network Board of directors Governance</p> <p>29. A meeting of the board of directors will be considered quorate when at least six members are present.</p>	<p>A meeting of the board of directors will be considered quorate when at least five members are present.</p>
<p>Special General Meeting</p> <p>42.The quorum at any general meeting of the Network must be one-third of the members.</p>	<p>The quorum at any general meeting of the Network must 12 members.</p>
